

# CONNECTICUT RUNNING CAMP

## CAMPER LIABILITY WAIVER

**IMPORTANT: READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING. THIS IS A LEGALLY BINDING DOCUMENT. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THIS FULLY SIGNED FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE CONNECTICUT RUNNING CAMP BEFORE ANY CAMPER IS ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY CAMP ACTIVITY.**

The Connecticut Running Camp is the provider of a running camp located in Rocky Hill, CT. The Connecticut Running Camp has contracted to provide the facility, staff, and maintenance services for the Camp. As consideration for, and as an express requirement of Camper's participation in camp activities, we require, and are materially relying on the requirement that you understand and agree to a waiver of any and all claims you might have against The Connecticut Running Camp, its directors, employees, agents, independent contractors and other representatives, as well as agree to be bound by other terms and conditions stated in this Waiver. As this is a binding legal document, you should read this document carefully before signing. By signing this Waiver, and to the extent permitted by law, you waive any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury, loss or property damage which you may have or which may hereafter accrue to you or your child against The Connecticut Running Camp, its directors, employees, agents, independent contractors and other representatives (hereinafter referred to jointly and severally as "The Connecticut Running Camp") as a result of your child's participation in the camp, and as related to the nature, type or condition of the events involved, and/or with respect to the condition of the sites involved, and/or with respect to the supervision provided, and/or with respect to the activities performed, whether or not caused by the negligence (active or passive) of The Connecticut Running Camp.

This Waiver is signed in order for your child to participate in this activity for his or her own personal enjoyment and benefit and is done so freely with full knowledge of the risk and dangers incident thereto. It is acknowledged that the Camper will be participating in an outdoor environment, with the inherent dangers and risks associated with running and general athletic activities. By signing this agreement, you further acknowledge that you agree to assume and bear sole responsibility for these dangers and risks and to absolve and hold harmless The Connecticut Running Camp from any and all risks of any nature and kind associated with Camp activities. You also agree to indemnify, defend, and hold The Connecticut Running Camp free and harmless from any and all expenses, demands, claims, costs, losses, damages, recoveries, settlements, and expenses (including but not limited to interest, penalties, attorney's fees, expert witness fees, costs, and other expenses) of any nature or kind which are incurred by the indemnity ("losses"), known or unknown, contingent or otherwise, directly or indirectly arising from or related to Staff family members' participation in Camp activities.

No refund or adjustment is made, and no prior notice is made, if The Connecticut Running Camp changes its program by adding, altering, or deleting activities as deemed necessary by the Camp Directors. It is also understood and agreed that The Connecticut Running Camp has made no promise or pledge, express or implied, to provide any special facilities or services to those with any medical problems, health problems, or physical disabilities, including but not limited to accommodation of special food/drink, and which The Connecticut Running Camp, in its sole discretion, predetermines it can reasonably provide based solely upon the information provided in said Medical Release and History Form.

Further, you understand and agree that, for the safety and comfort of everyone, the Camp is a non-smoking camp, and is in conformance with all applicable laws governing drug use, alcohol use by minors, environmental protection, health, and safety. Rules established to protect the property, privacy and safety of the Camp, Campers, and The Connecticut Running Camp will be enforced. Willful violation of Camp rules can lead to dismissal from Camp. The Connecticut Running Camp reserves the right to dismiss or remove campers for misbehavior at any time. You acknowledge that if Camper is dismissed or otherwise removed from the Camp you will be completely responsible for making arrangements for transportation, and that The Connecticut Running Camp shall make no refunds of any funds paid in association with this Camp.

This agreement hereby incorporates by reference in their entirety as if fully set forth herein, the Medical history and Release Form. To the extent there are any conflicting terms and conditions in the incorporated agreements hereto, this Camper Liability Waiver shall control and supersede any such provisions. This agreement shall represent the full and complete agreement between the parties, and any modification of the terms set forth herein shall be effective only if in writing and signed by all parties hereto. The parties to this agreement stipulate that this agreement shall be considered to have been entered into in Rocky Hill, CT, and that any interpretation of the terms of this agreement shall be made under Connecticut law, without respect to its conflict of laws provisions.
